



**Our location at 201 N Bardstown Road will have our doors open for you on Monday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>. We are excited to welcome you back inside to do your banking!**

We want to update you on a few things with you will be different when you come back in.

- We will be using the front lobby doors to enter the building and exiting the lobby using the doors on the south side of the lobby. We will have signs posted for you.
  - *The entrance on the north side of the building will not be open.*
- Glass shields have been installed along our teller windows and account/loan offices will have germ shields. Social distancing signs have been placed on the floors to help keep us all 6 feet apart.
- Our employees will be sanitizing the lobby area and their offices space several times each day.
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the lobby for you to use.
- If you are visiting our lobby to do a banking transaction, you will see that our employees are wearing masks. We encourage you to do the same but it is not required. *We reserve the right to request that you remove your face covering if we are not able to properly identify you.*
- If you need to open a new account, speak to a loan officer or an investment advisor, please continue to call 538-7301 for an appointment. We will ask that you wear a mask when coming to the bank for an appointment. If you do not have a mask we will provide one for you when you arrive for your appointment. We will not have waiting areas in the bank and ask that you call when you arrive and we will meet you in the lobby.
- Our branch located at 415 Oakbrooke Drive will continue to operate as drive thru only. Notification will be posted as soon as we resume lobby service at that location.
